



Acting Consul-General attended the inaugural flight ceremony
of Peach Aviation Osaka-Bangkok route

On 27 December 2022, Mrs. Merica Sivara, Deputy Consul-General and Acting Consul-General, attended the inaugural flight ceremony of Peach Aviation Osaka-Bangkok route at Kansai International Airport. Also present at the ceremony were Mr. Mori Takeaki, Chief Executive Officer of Peach Aviation, Mr. Francois Southarewsky, Chief Commercial Officer of Kansai International Airport Company and Miss Yada Surathammanan, Deputy Director of the Tourism Authority of Thailand, Osaka office.

On this occasion, the Acting Consul General congratulated Peach Aviation for its inaugural flight to Thailand, which will be another option for Thais, Japanese and foreigners to travel after the easing of immigration border control. It will also be the key to help promote Thai-Japanese relations, especially in the areas of tourism, economy and people-to-people exchanges.

Peach Aviation is a budget airline under the Air Nippon Airways (ANA) parent company. Established in 2011, it now operates 31 domestic routes and 17 international routes, including to South Korea, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Thailand, its latest route which operates 1 flight daily, 6 times a week. This is the first time Peach Aviation uses its new A321LR aircraft, which has 218 seats in one single class, to operate in Japan. Flight MM91 departs from Osaka at 19:30 hours and arrives in Bangkok at 00:10 local time, while flight MM92 departs from Bangkok at 1:10 hours and arrives in Osaka at 08:55 hours local time.
