



Acting Consul-General attends the Entrance Ceremony of the Global Business Course of the University of Hyogo



On 16 September 2022, Acting Consul-General Merica Sivara attends the Entrance Ceremony of the Global Business Course of the University of Hyogo in Hyogo Prefecture. A total of nine Thai students are enrolled in the course this year.

Global Business Course, originated in 2019, is taught entirely in English with a total study period of four years. In the first year, students will study liberal arts, Japanese language, culture and society. In the second year, students will learn micro and macro economics. In the third year, students will be taught advanced economics and field study. In the fourth year, students will do research and undergo internship. Upon completion of the program, students will graduate with a Bachelor degree in Economics. For this year, a total of 39 international students from 12 countries, namely Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, Romania, Mongolia, Taiwan, Turkey, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, Mozambique, Pakistan and Zambia joined the course.



For Thai students, Hyogo Prefecture and the University of Hyogo have supported scholarships based on the Memorandum of Understanding between the University of Hyogo and the Office of the Basic Education Commission, Ministry of Education. The scholarships not only help promote Hyogo Prefecture as the center for education and research but also assist in the human resource development of Hyogo Prefecture and Thailand.
