

Medical Treatment Visa (TR-MT/ Non-O)

Please make an appointment online [VABO] at www.thaiconsulate-visa.jp/vabo/ before visa application.

The Royal Thai Consulate-General, Osaka may require additional documents and reserves the right to reject incomplete visa application as well as fraud and misrepresentation. Visa issuance is under the discretion of the Royal Thai Consulate-General, Osaka. The Royal Thai Consulate General, Osaka reserves the right not to explain the reason of rejection.

- **Submission:** working days from 9:30-11:30 hrs. Please refer to www.thaiconsulate.jp for the official holidays of the Royal Thai Consulate-General, Osaka.
- **Collection:** from 13:30-15:00 hrs. 2 working days from submission date in the absence of error in the application form and required documents. (Visa processing time for certain nationals listed in the guideline for visa application published in our website is 45-60 days.)

All documents required must be issued within 15 days.

Step 1:

Applicant contacts hospital in Thailand that has been approved by the Ministry of Public Health (MOPH) to receive foreign patients and quarantine foreign patient and to send a request to the Department of Health Service Support (HSS), along with (1.1) Confirmation Letter (1.2) Affidavit of Support (1.3) Summary Form of Vehicles for Patients and other related documents such as a passport.

Step: 2

If approved, HSS will send the list of approved patients and accompanying family members to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to inform the Embassy to issue a Certificate of Entry (COE) and visa.

Step 3:

The applicant applies for visa and submit the following documents:

Completed and signed by the applicant

5. Copy of documents listed in step 1 approved by the Department of Health Service Support (HSS), Ministry of Public Health of Thailand

6. An original medical certificate/ medical documents/ evidence of medical treatment containing patient's detail, date of admission, purpose and necessity of treatment in Thailand and estimated duration of treatment issued by medical institute/ physician/ health care provider in Thailand

7. Original guarantee letter in English (http://www.thaiconsulate.jp/files/user/visa_pdf/Guarantee_Letter.pdf) **with the guarantor's identity documents**

- Guarantor must be over 20 years old and remains in Japan.
- Guarantor must be Japanese or non-Japanese who has the permanent residence in Japan.
- A photocopy of guarantor's passport or driving license (front and back side) duly signed by the guarantor.
- A photocopy of guarantor's passport and a residence card (front and back side) in case of non-Japanese guarantor.

8. Official financial evidence in English in Yen or Dollar of the applicant

Official bank statement in English and a copy of bank account of the applicant with the balance not less than 20,000 Thai baht for each traveler or 40,000 Thai baht per family

*Applicants aged under 20 years old can submit the bank statement of his/her family member with an original certificate of family register or certificate of residence.

9. Airline ticket or flight booking confirmation

Airline ticket or booking confirmation of the flights from Japan to Thailand and from Thailand to the applicant's destination with the applicant's name and flight details (flight numbers/ date and time of arrival and departure) issued by airline or travel company.
